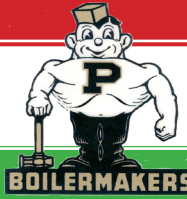

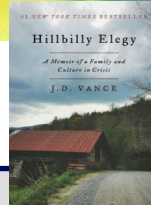

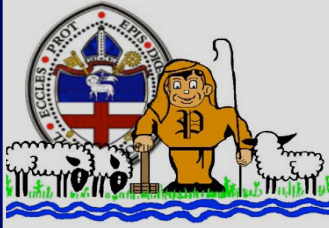
UPDATE YOUR INFORMATION !
